Challenges to Overcome:

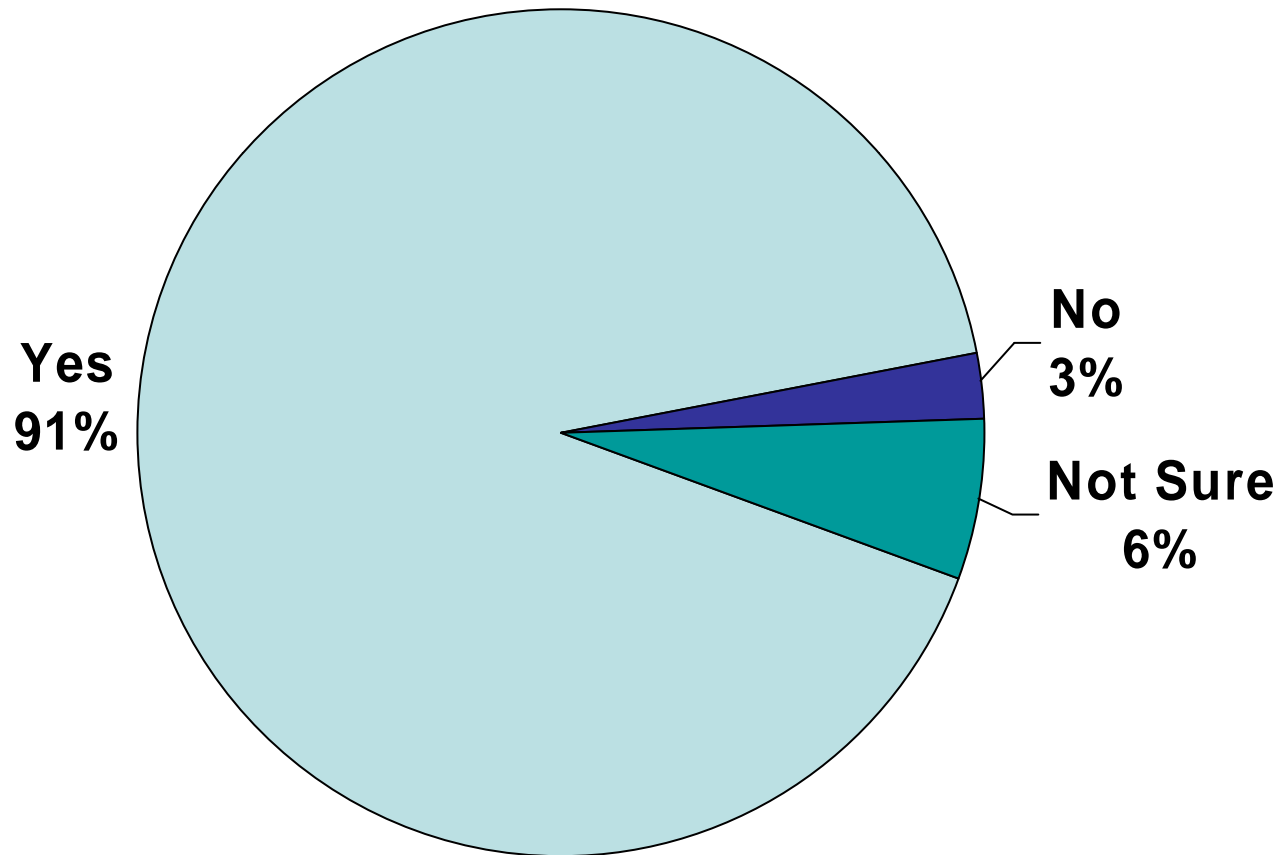
- Underserved Native American population

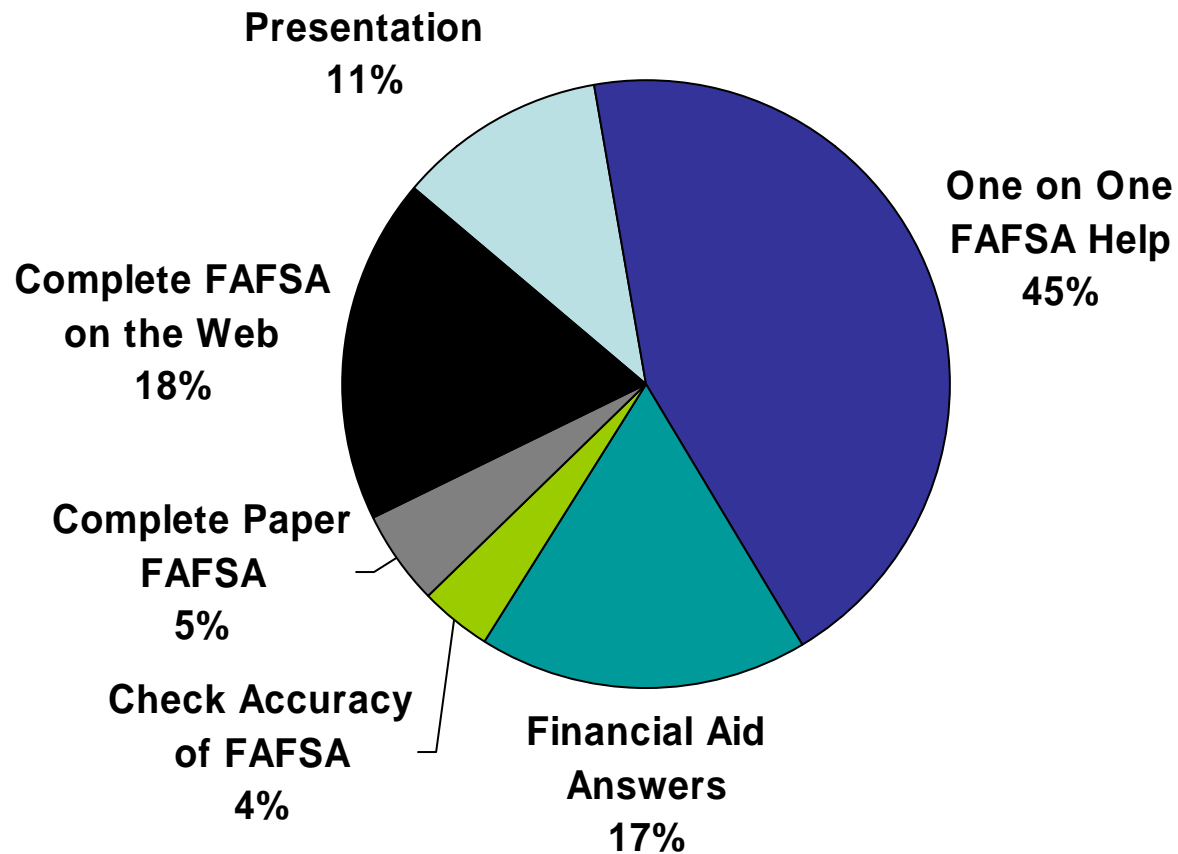

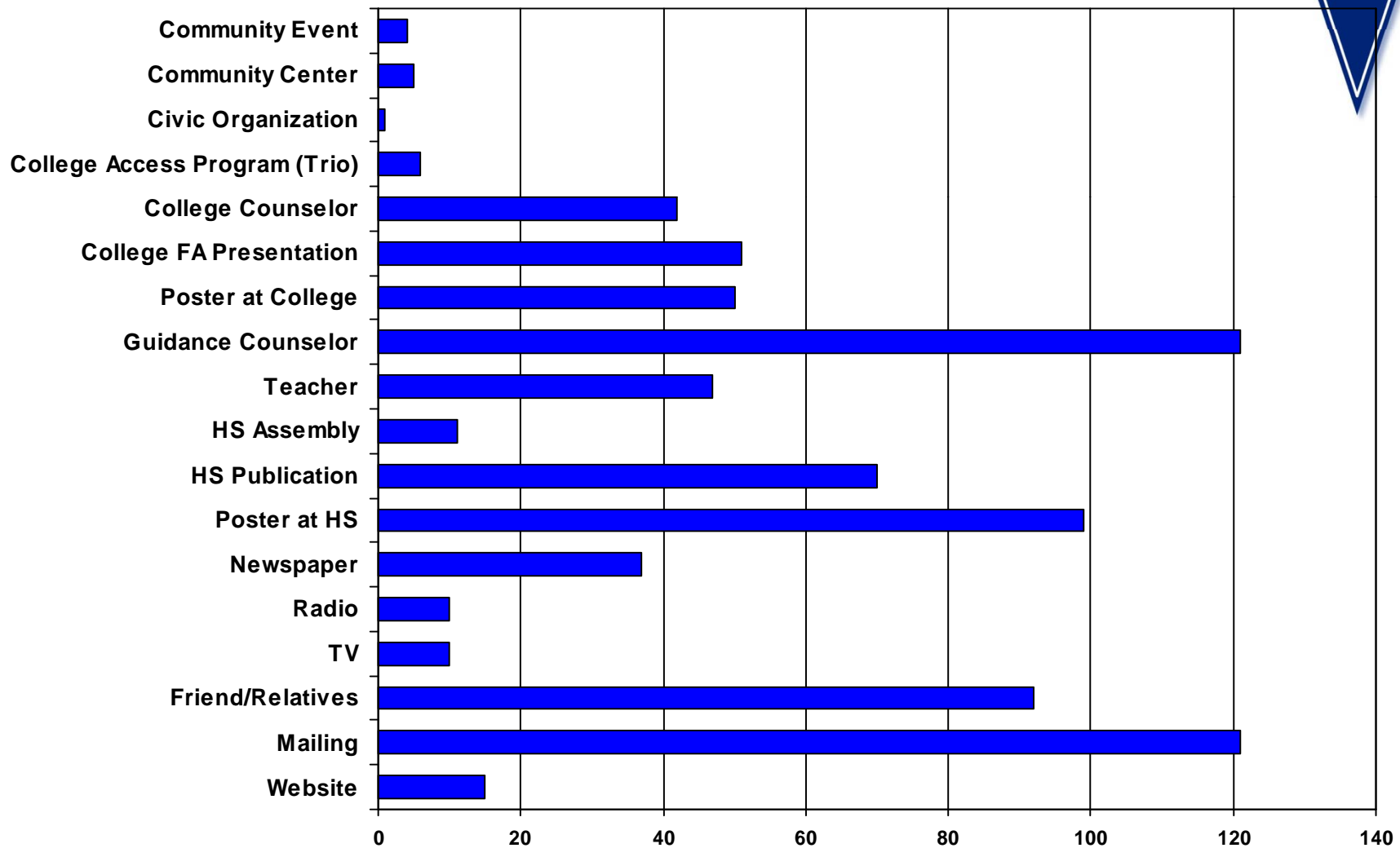


Most Helpful Aspects of CGS



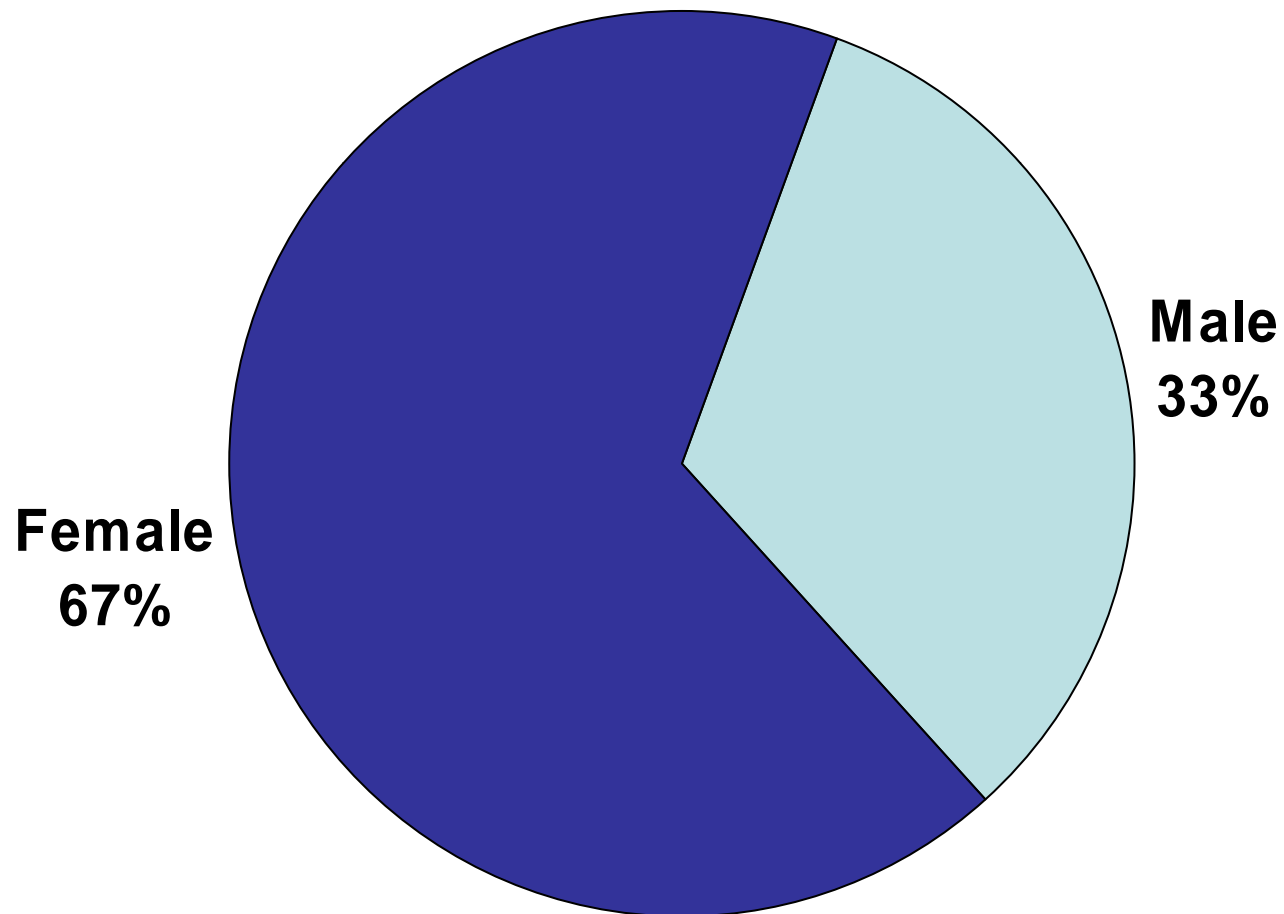


How Did You Hear About CGS?



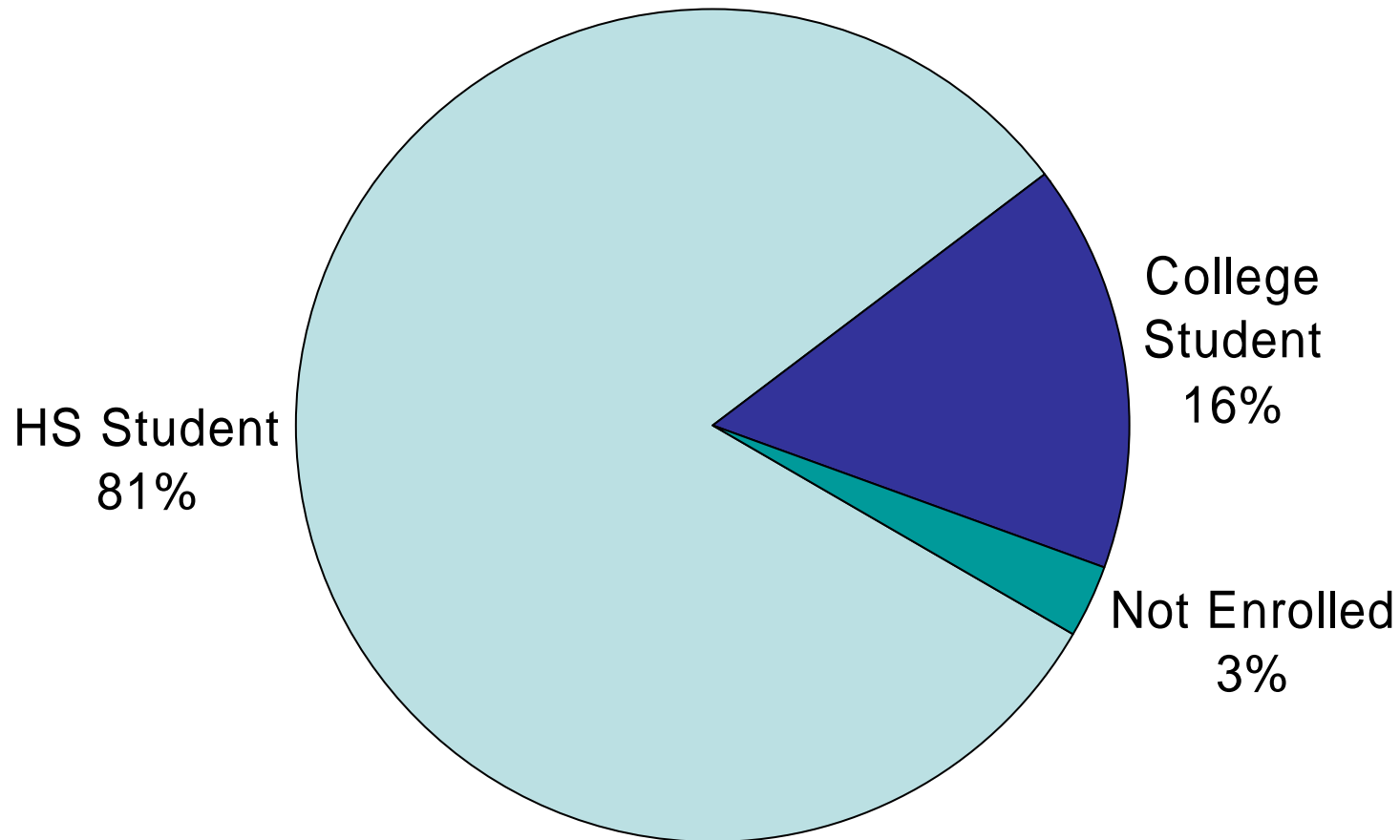


Attendance by Gender

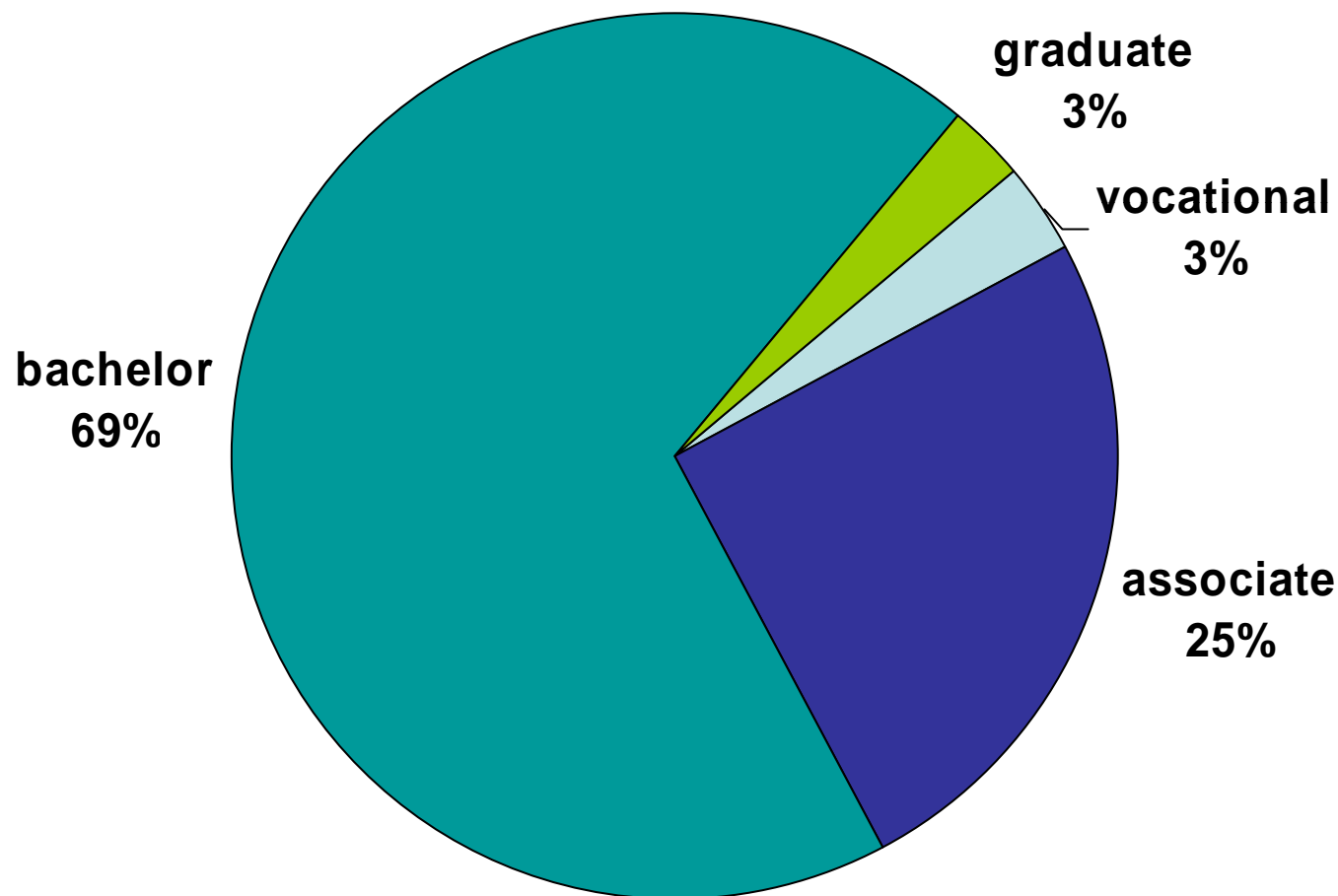




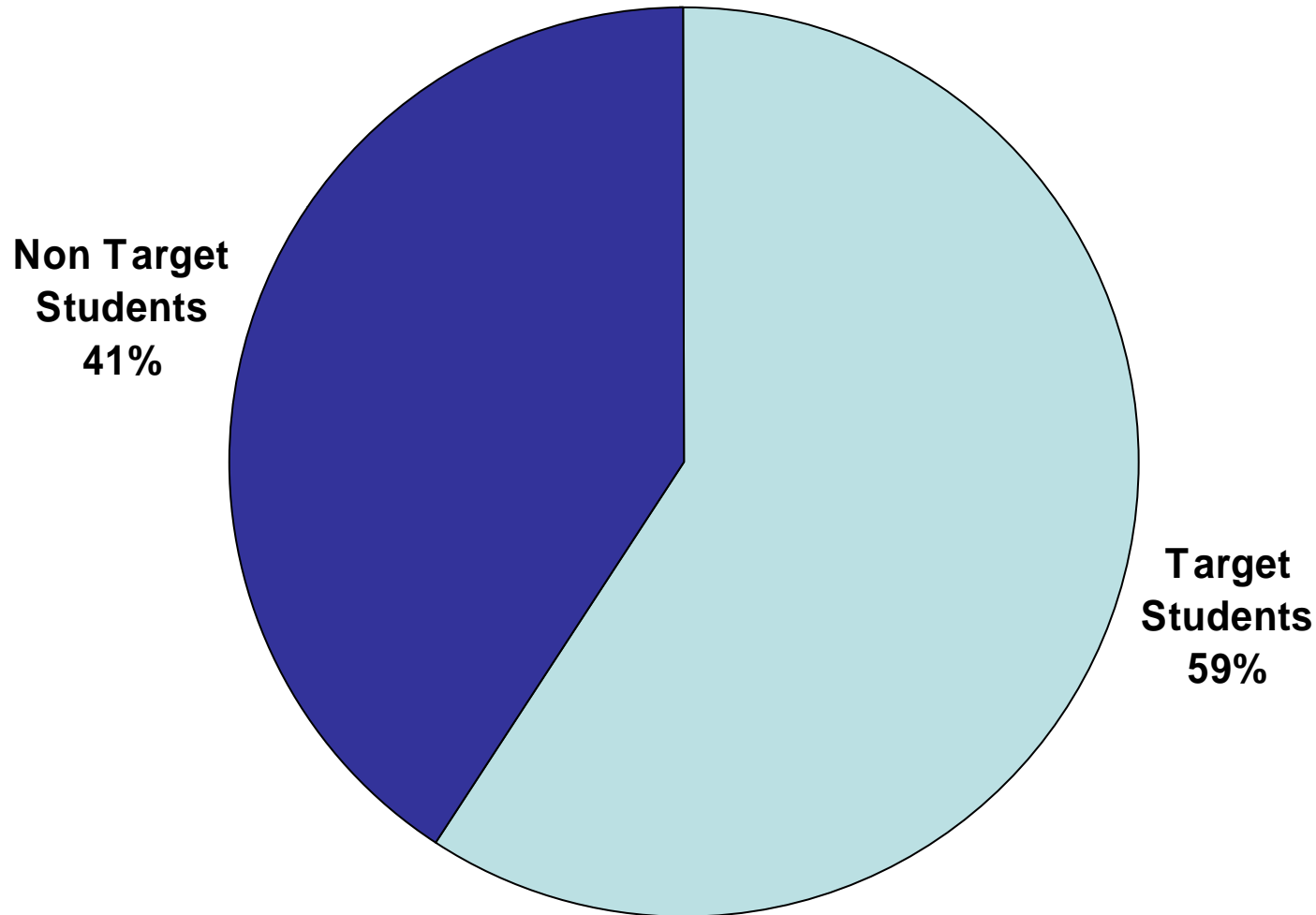
Current Education Status



Degree program student hopes to enroll in fall

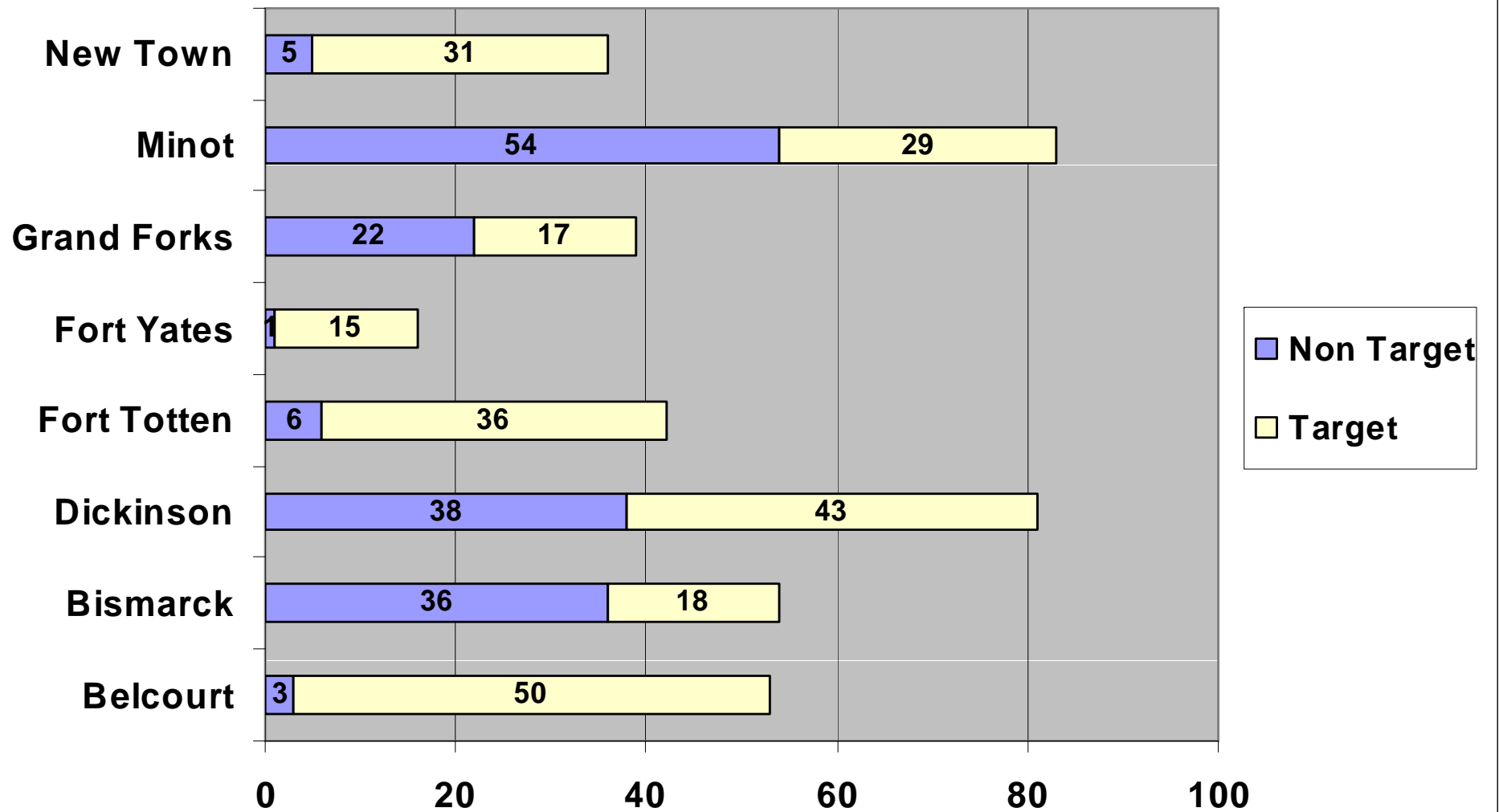


Did we serve our Target Audience?
